York Handmade Tiles look beautiful and old from the first day of laying. The finish is hardwearing and improves over the years. York Handmade Tiles are made from Lacustrine clay found in the Vale of York. The tiles are rough, sometimes bent and very individual. The tiles are extruded, hand-finished, predominantly red smooth but with patches of dark red and yellow tinges. The colour is essentially a random blend.

Antiquing: You will note that in our illustration, of the tile range, we are able to offer our TFT in different finishes. The natural colour (multi shades of red) uses a clear sealer and polish whereas the antiquing finish is obtained by applying a different type of sealer which is derived from beeswax. The procedure is equally simple, but the result is a highly attractive, oak coloured finish.

Fixing & Sealing: all users must read the recommended procedure for fixing and sealing our floor tiles before use. One of the most important points, in this leaflet, is the need to ensure that the tiles are totally dry before the sealer is applied. If you have any doubts, about the fixing and sealing procedure, please contact our office before your tiles are laid.




